### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Special thanks to Lisa Gibbons who serves as director of Vacation Bible School. The theme of the week was “Stellar - Shine Jesus’ Light.” The program reminded the children that we are called to shine Jesus’ light.

Monday we celebrate the Feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola, Priest. St. Ignatius was the founder of the Jesuits. According to the *Ordo*, at the time of his death in 1556, “the Society numbered 1000 members in seventy-six houses in twelve provinces, including Brazil, Japan, and India; today numbers some 15,300 members....” In Indianapolis, Brebeuf High School is a ministry of the Jesuits. My first three years in Rome I attended the Pontifical Gregorian University, a Jesuit university.

Monday is also the anniversary of the death of Fr. Thomas Finneran in 1968. Fr. Finneran served briefly as associate pastor of Little Flower in the early 1960’s.

Tuesday is the feast of St. Alphonsus Liguori, bishop and doctor of the Church. St. Alphonsus was a lawyer who founded the Redemptorists. He was one of the greatest moral theologians in the history of the Church. Cardinal Tobin was a member of the Redemptorists.

Friday is the feast of St. John Vianney, the Curé of Ars. He is the patron saint of priests, especially parish priests. He heard confessions for 16 hours/day during the summer and up to 11 hours/day in the winter. Friday would be a good day to pray for an increase of vocations to the priesthood.

This week we celebrate the feasts of three priests who could not have been more different from each other. Ignatius had been a soldier; Alphonsus had been a lawyer; John Vianney was a parish priest. Each of these unique individuals placed his gifts and talents in the service of Christ and the Church. We are all unique individuals, and we are called to place our gifts and talents in the service of Christ and the Church in our own unique way.

Jackie Metz, my brother’s mother-in-law, died last Monday, July 24. She was 95 years old. On July 9, she and her husband (John) had celebrated their 74<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary. I will turn 74 next Sunday. They were married longer than I was alive! They were a remarkable witness to the meaning of lifelong marriage. Please pray for Jackie and John, my brother and sister-in-law, and their family.

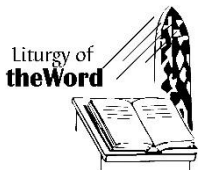

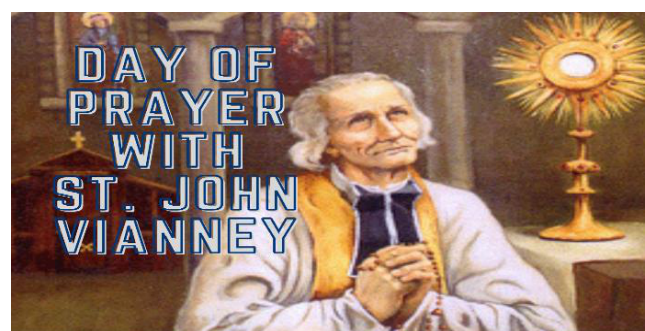
