Dear Parish Family,

Monday, August 14, is the feast of St. Maximilian Marie Kolbe, priest and martyr. St. Maximilian is a contemporary saint killed by the Nazis at Auschwitz in 1941. In reprisal for the escape of three prisoners, ten men where chosen to be killed by starvation. St. Maximilian was not among them. However, when a young husband and father cried out, "My wife! My children!" St. Maximilian freely chose to take his place. After the other nine had died, he was killed by lethal injection. Franciszek Gajowniczek, the Polish soldier for whom he died, was present at his beatification and canonization. His wife survived the war, but his sons did not.

The first papal Mass I attended as a student in Rome was his beatification by Pope Paul VI on October 17, 1971. The Communist government of Poland allowed thousands of Poles to attend. When Pope Paul VI entered St. Peter's Basilica to begin Mass, I could feel the electricity in the air. I do not think I have ever attended a Mass where there was so much energy in the congregation.

This Tuesday, August 15, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holyday of Obligation. The Assumption celebrates our belief that at the end of her earthly life, Mary was taken up body and soul into heaven. Although the Assumption was celebrated as a feast day for centuries, the dogma of the Assumption was defined by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950. Holyday Masses will be at 9:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Are you interested in knowing about the Catholic Faith? Sessions (RCIA) for adults will begin on Tuesday, September 5, from 7 to 8:30 p.m. in the Parish Center. If you are interested in learning more about the Catholic Church, becoming Catholic, or if you have been baptized Catholic and have not made First Communion or Confirmation, call Lisa at 317-357-8352 ext. 105, or email lgibbons@littleflowerparish.org for more information. We also need our parish community's help to welcome others to the Church. If you know of anyone who is in need of a Church community, let us know! There are forms you can fill out on the Altar with the names of people who are interested, and we will contact them.

Please take a look at the letter in the bulletin from The Rohn-Gleason Family, who went through RCIA and RCIC last year. It is a powerful testimony of their faith journey.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the Church's process for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation—Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. The Rite speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." The RCIA process is a restoration of the ancient catechumenate that arose within the first three centuries following the era of the apostles. The Second Vatican Council called for the restoration and use of this venerable and powerful method of initiation for the worldwide Church.

I would like to thank the Invite Commission for hosting National Night Out on August 2. This was an opportunity for neighborhood families to come together for an evening of fun and games. In addition to hot dogs & chips, there was live entertainment. Members of the sheriff's department, including Sheriff Kerry Forestal, and IMPD were present as was Mayor Hogsett. School supplies were given out to those who needed them, and the Invite Commission passed out holy cards, rosaries, and religious necklaces.. Special thanks goes to all those who helped with this event, including those who set up all the tables and chairs, grilled the hotdogs, donated school supplies, provided entertainment, and helped with clean up. It was an enjoyable evening for all those in attendance.

Finally, I want to thank all of you who helped me celebrate my birthday with greetings, cards, and presents. Little Flower parishioners have long had a reputation for kindness to their pastors. You are always kind and thoughtful to me.





We'll be with you in prayer throughout your faith journey and this school year.


