Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Next weekend Fr. Giltus Mathias CP, a Passionist priest originally from India, now a Passionist missionary of the Holy Spirit Province, which includes Australia, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea and Vietnam, will ask for our prayers and financial support for their missions in Papua New Guinea. You may remember that it was to Papua, New Guinea, that the Sisters of St. Francis from Oldenburg were sent in 1960. Please check out the announcement elsewhere in *The Theresean*.

Monday, August 21, is the feast of St. Pius X. St. Pius X was Pope from 1903 until 1914. Many Catholics mistakenly believe that the reform of the Liturgy only began with Vatican II. However, it was Pope Pius X who lowered the age of First Communion from 12 to 7. He also encouraged frequent, if not daily, Communion. He also revived the use of Gregorian Chant in the Mass.

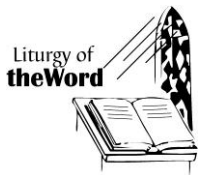
Tuesday is the feast of the Queenship of Mary. This feast was added to the liturgical calendar by Pope Pius XII in 1954. Originally, it was celebrated on May 31 but was later moved to August 22, the octave day of the Solemnity of the Assumption. It was Pope Pius XII who infallibly defined the dogma of the Assumption on November 1, 1950.

Thursday is the Feast of St. Bartholomew, Apostle. Bartholomew in the Synoptic Gospels is Nathaniel in John's Gospel. It is believed that Bartholomew is a surname meaning "the son of Tolmai." When Nathaniel approaches Jesus, Jesus, knowing his heart, praises him: "'Here is a true Israelite. There is no duplicity in him'" [Jn. 1:47]. Jesus praised him for being a person of integrity and, therefore, a person of character. I once read that our character is defined by the commitments we make and the commitments we keep.

Finally, on a positive note, last Friday, August 18, was Peggy Clegg's birthday. If you get an opportunity, please wish her a belated happy birthday and thank her for everything she does for the parish. Although her title is Pastoral Associate for Health & Senior Ministries, Peggy does so much more for the parish, especially working with our Parish Life Commission and the *Invite* Commission. Peggy, belated happy birthday!

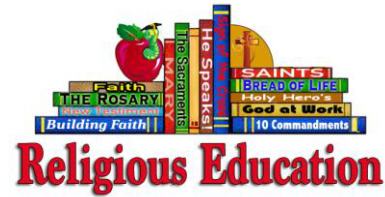

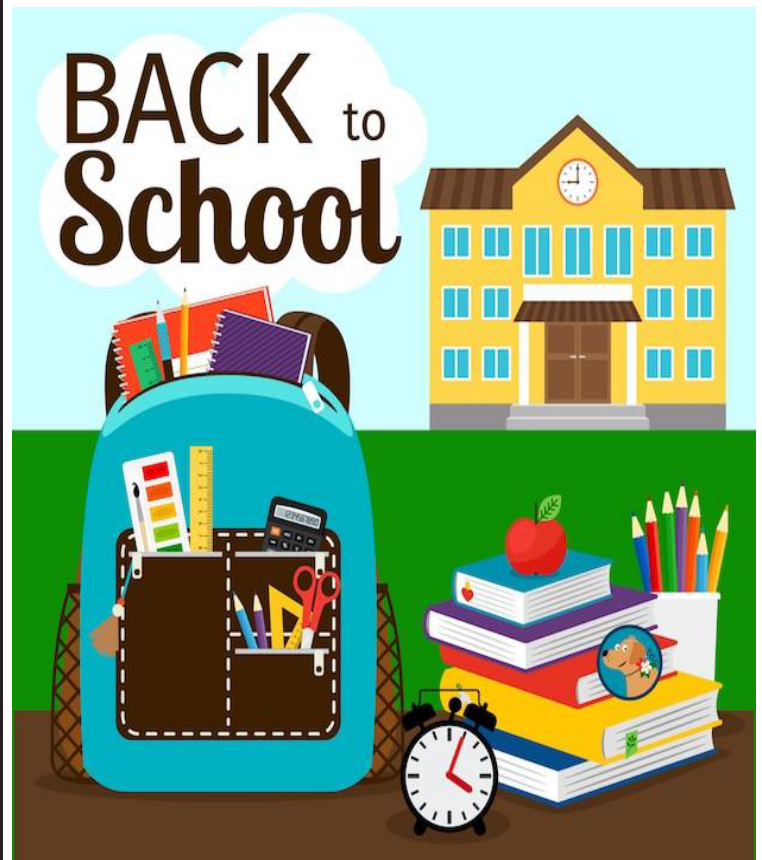
