### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, the last Sunday of the Church year. This feast was instituted by Pope Pius XI at the close of the 1925 Holy Year. He wanted to emphasize the kingship of Christ over all creation. In the Preface of the Mass, we pray, "You anointed Jesus Christ, your only Son, with the oil of gladness, as the eternal priest and universal king."

Today we commission all of our lectors, servers, music ministers, ministers of hospitality, and arts and environment ministers at all of our weekend Masses. We very much appreciate the contributions of these ministers who enrich our liturgy on a weekly basis.

Next Sunday will be the First Sunday of Advent, the beginning of a new church year. Also, Giving Tree tags will be available next Sunday. Please note the full announcement about the Giving Tree. The Giving Tree gifts are one way in which we become Christ to others, and they become Christ to us. Also, please mark your calendar for our Advent Penance Service, which will be Wednesday, December 6, at 7 p.m. at Our Lady of Lourdes.

Our second outstanding alumnus this year was Joe Meyer, Class of 1982. Joe and his older sister, Mary Jo, were raised by their mother, Mary Ann Meyer, at 1701 N. Bosart.

After graduating from Seccina Memorial High School, Joe earned a BBA (bachelor's in business administration) in Finance and Economics from the University of Notre Dame and an MBA in Marketing and Strategy from the Kellogg School of Management at Northwestern University.

Joe currently is Senior Vice President, System Operations for Indiana University Health where he leads a team of 4,000 with responsibility for a diverse portfolio, including Supply Chain, Clinical Laboratory Services, Support Services, Safety & Security, and Business Process Excellence. He is responsible for approximately \$1.8 billion in annual spend.

During the pandemic, he was a key part of the health system's Incident Command structure that gave the state a master class in leadership. He was integral in obtaining PPE and the testing equipment that helped to save the lives of thousands of Hoosiers.

Joe's skill in team building was instrumental in bringing the entire 2021 March Madness tournament to Indianapolis...Joe was part of a team that established protocols and procedures keeping players and spectators safe, while providing a huge economic boom to the community, the NCAA and the state. The excitement was contagious and with a year into lockdowns, quarantines and isolation, that tournament helped to lift the spirits of many a Hoosier...

Joe and his wife Angela celebrated their 30<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary this past summer and have delighted in raising their four children: Teresa, Kathleen, Karl, and Caroline. He is active at Immaculate Heart of Mary parish, including serving as President of the pastoral council and as a musician for weekend Masses.

For being a devoted husband and father, a parish leader, and an outstanding servant leader at IU Health, we honored Joe Meyer as an outstanding alumnus of Little Flower Catholic School.

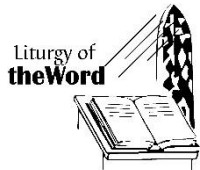

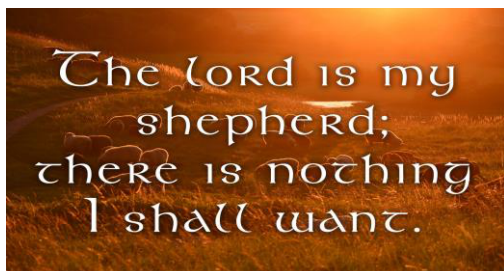
