



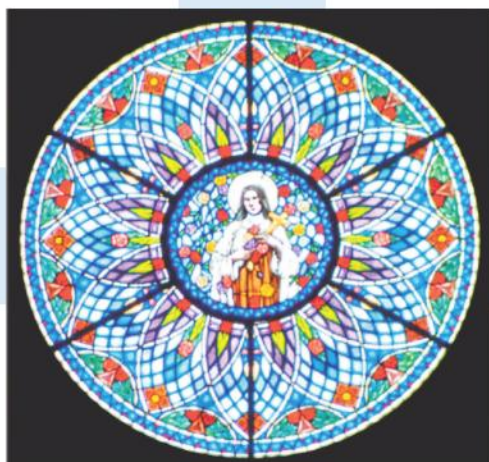

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

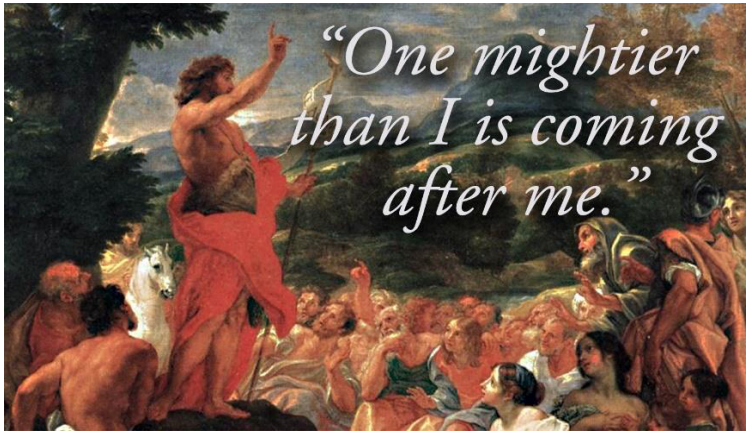

Dear Parish Family,

Last Sunday, before the 9:30 a.m. Mass and during the 6:00 p.m. Mass, one of our neighbors came over to complain about parishioners parking on her property. Please do not park on 13th Street beside the house on the northwest corner of 13th and Bosart (1302 N. Bosart). The light of Christ cannot shine through us when we are not good neighbors.

Thanks to the members of the Parish Life Commission for hosting *Journey into Advent: Faith, Family, & Fun* on November 29 and thanks to the families who attended.

On Tuesday, December 12, we will celebrate the Feast of our Lady of Guadalupe with an all-school Mass at 9:30 a.m. This feast commemorates the appearance of the Blessed Mother to St.

Juan Diego on the hill of Tepeyac from December 9 to December 12 in 1531. Our Lady of Guadalupe was declared patroness of the Americas by Pope Pius XII and was raised to the level of Feast for all the countries of the Americas in 1999. St. Juan Diego was canonized by St. John Paul II on July 31, 2002. His feast is December 9.

Thursday, December 14, is the 28th anniversary of the death of Fr. Robert Borchertmeyer. Fr. Bob was killed in a traffic accident returning home from a Penance Service in 1995. Fr. Bob served as associate pastor of Little Flower from 1958-1968 and as pastor of Little Flower from 1985-1995. On Thursday, please pray for him and for our parish.

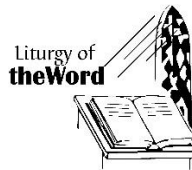
Holiday Bulletin Deadlines
