

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.



Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Today we want to pray for all families that they will model themselves after the Holy Family. However, with all the violence in the world, we also want to pray for the human family that we all see ourselves as children of the same God and, therefore, brothers and sisters of one another.

This Monday, January 1, is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. Normally, January 1 is a Holyday of Obligation. However, this year, because it falls on Monday, it is not a Holyday of Obligation. Therefore, the only Mass for the Solemnity will be Monday, January 1, at 9:30 a.m.

January 1 has also been designated as a Day of Prayer for World Justice and Peace. The theme for Pope Francis' annual World Day of Peace message for 2024 is "Artificial Intelligence and Peace." Of course, January 1 is also New Year's Day.

Therefore, I want to strongly encourage you to attend Mass on Monday. The parish office will be closed on Monday, January 1.

Due to some recent incidents of unauthorized access to the church, which included thefts and damage, we have changed the code to enter the church from the door nearest the rectory. To obtain the new code, please contact Jeannie in the parish office at 317-357-8352, or ask any parish staff member. If you have obtained the code, you may only give it to someone else as long as you know and trust that person.

Although we realize this is the adoration chapel for the East Deanery, anyone whom we do not know will need to come to the parish center between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to sign in and show their ID. The sign up sheet asks for the date, time, name, address, phone number and parish of anyone we do not know who wants access to the chapel or church. We will also ask them to show ID to verify that they are who they say they are. They will only need to sign in once.

Also, when you enter and exit the church through that door, please make sure it closes and latches properly before you walk away.

I am sorry that we have to become more security conscious and for any inconvenience this may cause.

As 2023 ends and 2024 begins, I once again want to thank our parish staff for everything they do throughout the year. I want to thank our school staff for their commitment to providing a Catholic school education to our students.

Also, I want to offer a special thank you to all those who took tags from the Giving Trees and all those who organized the gifts and distributed them. I am sure many children and many people in nursing homes had a brighter Christmas because of your generosity.

Finally, the entire parish staff and I want to wish you a blessed New Year. In the Old Testament Book of Numbers [6:24-26], God prescribed the blessing with which Aaron and his descendants would bless the Israelites. This blessing is particularly appropriate at the beginning of the New Year:

The LORD bless you and keep you!

The LORD let his face shine upon you, and be gracious to you!

The LORD look upon you kindly and give you peace!




