

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

#### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

#### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord, Jesus' manifestation to the Gentiles. Epiphany has often been called Little Christmas. In Western Christianity, Christmas is the primary feast. However, in Eastern Christianity Epiphany is the more important and older feast. In some cultures, gift giving is part of the celebration of the Epiphany. In earlier times, the Church celebrated three mysteries on the Solemnity of the Epiphany: the visit of the Magi, Jesus' baptism by John, and the wedding feast at Cana.

Because Christmas fell on Monday this year, we will celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord this Monday, January 8. Monday, then, will mark the conclusion of the liturgical season of Christmas. Ordinary Time begins on Tuesday, and the liturgical color returns to green.

The Sunday Gospels this year will come primarily from the Gospel of Mark. Mark's Gospel is the oldest Gospel and the shortest Gospel. Therefore, *Invite* is offering a study of this Gospel. Evening classes start this Tuesday, January 9, at 6:30 p.m., and afternoon sessions begin this Thursday, January 11, at 1 p.m. Check the Theresean announcement for details, sign up at the back of Church this weekend, or just show up for the first session.

During Christmas, two areas of ministry are at the heart of our parish life: our liturgical ministries and our community outreach ministries.

Many visitors, including many former parishioners, attend our Christmas Liturgies. Invariably, I hear many wonderful comments about Christmas at Little Flower. Therefore, I want to thank everyone who worked so hard to make our Christmas Liturgies beautiful celebrations of faith, love, and worship.

Special thanks to Gavin Craig, our regular music ministers, all those who participated in Christmas choir, and all the additional instrumentalists who provided life and energy to our Christmas Liturgies. When people compliment our Liturgies, they primarily compliment our music.

Also, special thanks to Holly Hodges, the Arts and Environment Committee, the Men's Club, and all the other volunteers who helped decorate the Church for Christmas on Wednesday evening, December 20. Every year people say that Little Flower is the most beautiful church at Christmas.

Thanks also to all of our Liturgical ministers who generously served in their ministries during this Christmas season: Eucharistic ministers, lectors, servers, hospitality ministers, sacristans, and church cleaners. Although we highlight music and arts and environment at Christmas, all liturgical ministers play a major part in making our Liturgies beautiful and prayerful and our community welcoming.

I would especially like to thank the Saint Vincent de Paul Society and the Gabriel Project and everyone who brought Giving Tree Gifts for those in need in our community or baby gifts for those served by the Gabriel Project. These ministries help bring Christ and Christmas into the lives of those less fortunate than we are. We should never forget that these ministries are as important to the mission of the church as the liturgical ministries.

On a personal note, once again I want to thank you for your Christmas gifts to me. You are a wonderfully generous and supportive parish. I am working on thank you notes. If I fail to send a thank you to anyone who gave me a Christmas gift, I apologize. Fr. Jim Moriarty, with whom I lived at St. Matthew from 1980-1985, always emphasized the importance of thank you notes. Also, I want to thank the giver of the one anonymous gift I received. Someone sent me a t-shirt with the words "I V Kickball." It was one of my favorite gifts.

Finally, recently several people have asked me why we have not returned to six cups at Mass, especially at Masses we know will have more people, such as Christmas Masses. For us to add back the two cups, we would need many more Eucharistic ministers and head Eucharistic ministers. We lost so many Eucharistic ministers during COVID who have not returned. If you are interested in serving as a Eucharistic minister, please call the parish office.
