SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

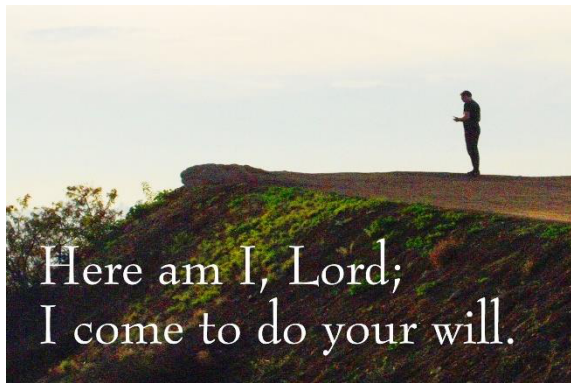

Dear Parish Family,

This Monday, January 15, our nation celebrates the birth of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Both our parish office and our school will be closed in honor of Dr. King. I am always moved by Dr. King's words in his "I Have a Dream" speech delivered on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial on August 28, 1963: "I have a dream that my four children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color or their skin but by the content of their character." In that same speech, Dr. King reminded his listeners, "...unearned suffering is redemptive."

Thursday begins the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (January 18-25). Traditionally January 18 was the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter at Rome. January 25 was and is the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul.

For the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2024, the theme is "You shall love the Lord your God....and your neighbor as yourself," from the Gospel of Luke [10:27]. "The theme...reflects the connection between love of God and love of neighbor with a particular concern for challenging the boundaries of who is considered 'neighbor'. In this pericope, Jesus is questioned as to the path to eternal life. His answer is not to only observe the commandments, but to also imitate the love of God in the giving of self for another. It is called charity, mercy, justice, and unity."

As you know, we have been trying to promote the Eucharistic Revival and the upcoming Eucharistic Congress that will take place in Indianapolis in July. Therefore, I hope that everyone is aware of both. While traveling, Cindy Woods, the parish council representative for *Invite*, and her husband stopped in at St. Theresa parish. They asked the pastor and parish secretary if anyone from their parish planned to attend. She wrote, "It was like a Saturday Night Live skit. The pastor and the secretary had NO IDEA what we were talking about, and the more I tried to explain the more confused they got. So finally, I just wrote down my contact information and a few details and left." As with most things, personal invitations are the best.

Thanks to Shirley Brothers Mortuaries who provide our calendars each year.

Over the years, when people wonder about the roots of my vocation to the priesthood, I have often been asked if I had relatives who were priests or sisters. The only priest in our family that I know of was Msgr. Henry F. Dugan, a distant cousin whom I never met. He was chancellor of the Archdiocese from 1935 until 1957. He was ordained on May 25, 1916 and died on January 16, 1957. When he died, I was only seven.

Finally, please pray for the repose of the soul of Sr. Marie Camille Schmaltz, O.S.F., who died on December 29, 2023 at the age of 95. She taught at Little Flower from 1963 to 1965.

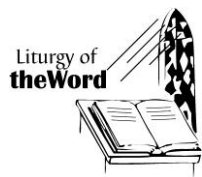

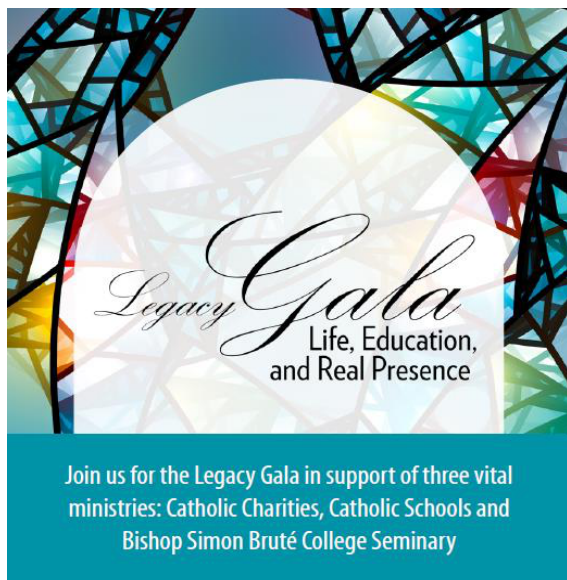
