

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Dear Parish Family,

Our school open house is this Sunday, January 28, from 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. We invite ALL parishioners, but especially the parents of young children, to come and see the great work that is taking place in your school. If you have school-age children, please consider what a Little Flower Catholic education can provide your children. If you have friends or family, please invite them to visit. Appropriately, Wednesday is the feast of St. John Bosco, an educator. St. John Bosco is known as the Apostle of Youth. He founded the Salesian Order which is dedicated to educating youth. He was also a pioneer in vocational education. CYO's highest award for youth volunteers is the St. John Bosco medal.

Next Sunday, February 4, will be our annual Volunteer and Ministry Fair, which will allow parishioners to explore all of the ministries and volunteer opportunities available here at Little Flower. Also, once again this year our PPS will host a Pancake Breakfast in conjunction with the fair at no cost to you. 
