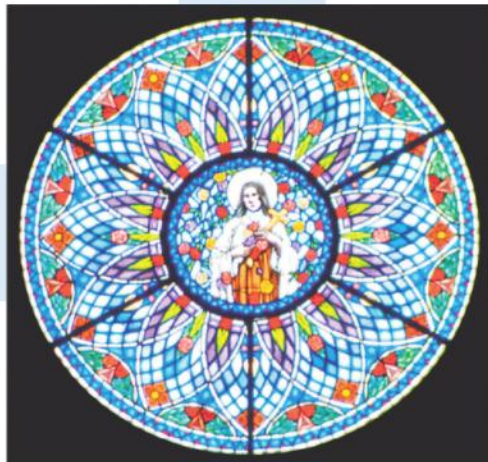

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are held on most Sundays during the year. Baptisms are held after the 9:30 am Mass. If you prefer to have your child's baptism scheduled during Mass, you may request this at the time you return the baptism information form. Requests for the date and time specified will be honored to the extent possible. Parents who have not yet received pre-baptismal instruction are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class that is held 5 times per year. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements may be made.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Contact the priest 9 to 12 months in advance. A Wedding Handbook is available from the Parish Office which provides the necessary information on arranging for a marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

In an emergency, contact the parish at any time. Please contact the Parish Center if you or a loved one are hospitalized, or are confined to home or a nursing facility, to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

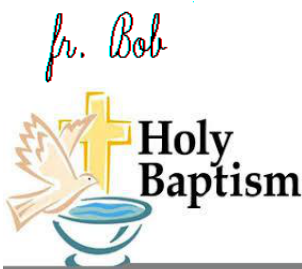



Little Flower Ladies Club

For nearly a century, the Little Flower Ladies Club, (formerly known as the “Little Flower Altar Society and Social Club”) has supported the Church’s efforts to beautify and maintain the sanctuary, which was their primary purpose in the beginning. That purpose continues today along with educational programs, social outings, monthly meetings, annual plant sale, fellowship, bake sales, fish fry desserts, and flowers for holiday decorating in church. The Ladies Club is open to any woman of the parish 18 years and older with annual membership dues of \$15.00. Each year funds are given to the parish at the end of the fiscal year to help with the general budget. Participation has dwindled in the past several years, indicating a lack of interest in participating in this ministry or perhaps not understanding what the Ladies Club does for the parish. Spring is time for our election of officers, and we have the following offices open – President and 1st Vice President. The other offices are being filled by dedicated women who have committed to another year in their current office. If we are unable to fill these offices, the Ladies Club will have to disband. What a shame to witness a 100-year-old ministry come to an end.
