

**Day 4** – Friday, September 26 - Service in church at 5:30 p.m.

**Day 5** – Saturday, September 27 – prayers at 5:30 p.m. Mass

Day 6 - Sunday, September 28 - prayers at 9:00 a.m. Mass

**Days 7 thru 8** – Monday and Tuesday, September 29 and 30 – service in church at 5:30 p.m.

**Day 9** – Wednesday, October 1 – Solemn Closing and Benediction at 5:30 p.m. with First Communion Candidates in procession.

We will celebrate the Feast of St. Therese at all Masses on the weekend of September 27 and 28.
