

The Archbishop has allowed specific days that we are allowed to accept multiple Mass Intentions for the same Mass, so long as all of those offering the intentions are informed that the Mass will have more than one intention.

One of those days for which an exception is granted is Christmas. We can accept multiple intentions for Christmas Masses. If you are interested in offering a specific intention for either the 5:30 p.m. or the 10:00 p.m. Mass on Christmas Eve, please contact Jeannie at the parish office, 317-357-8352.

The bishops of the Province of Indiana have set the ordinary amount of a financial offering at \$10.



#### **PEW REFINISHING UPDATE**

AS ANNOUNCED PREVIOUSLY, THE SHOP DOING OUR PEW REFINISHING TOOK TWO PEWS FROM CHURCH, WITH THE INTENT TO STAIN ONE WITH A LIGHTER SHADE AND ONE WITH A MEDIUM (DARKER) STAIN. THEY WILL RETURN THOSE PEWS TO US SOMETIME THE WEEK OF DECEMBER 15. WE WILL DEVISE A WAY TO COLLECT YOUR INPUT AS TO PREFERENCE.

ONCE A DECISION IS MADE ON THE STAIN TO BE USED, THEY WILL BEGIN TO REMOVE THE PEWS, IN SECTIONS, IN EARLY TO MID-JANUARY.

AS SECTIONS OF PEWS ARE MISSING, OUR CHURCH FLOOR WILL BE PROFESSIONALLY CLEANED AND POLISHED.
