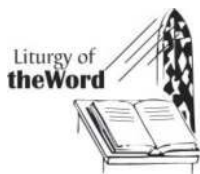
The next **Baptism Preparation Class is Monday, April 27, at 7:00 p.m. in the Parish Center.**

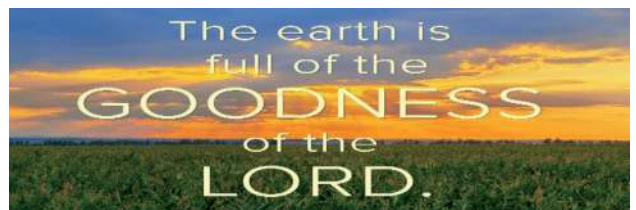
